BRISTOL CONDUCTING COMMUNITY OPINION SURVEY

The Bristol Planning Board is conducting a comprehensive survey of residents and property owners regarding a number of issues of concern to the town. The results of the survey will guide the revision of the Master Plan and will help shape any needed changes in the zoning ordinance and the town's site plan and subdivision regulations.

Since the survey is similar to ones done in 2007 and 2013, it will help the Planning Board identify trends in public opinion. Questions range from rating current facilities and services to issues of growth in the Bristol area. Several of the questions give respondents an opportunity to express their main concerns in their own words.

As was done when the previous surveys were taken, respondents to this year's survey are being encouraged to complete it online by going to the town's website, www.townofbristolnh.org, and clicking on the link on the home page. A print version of the survey is also available at the Town Offices at 230 Lake Street.

The survey will be under way as of Monday, October 15 and will be available on line through mid-November. The Planning Board is hoping for a large response from Bristol's residents and property owners.
