

# **BRISTOL'S SANITARY SEWER CLEANING NOTICE**

The Town of Bristol Water and Sewer Department will be cleaning sanitary sewer mains beginning 5/1/2017 and continue periodically for the following 4 weeks.

You may see the cleaning crew with a trailer mounted unit on the following roads:

**Worfield Circle, Timber Lane, Robieson Drive, Fourth, Prospect, Beech, Third, Walnut, Church, High, South Main, North Main Streets**

If you live on one of these roads, we will attempt to contact you when we are cleaning the main in front of your property.

These sanitary sewer lines are cleaned using high performance sewer cleaning equipment.

A cleaning nozzle is propelled from one manhole to the next using water under high pressure.

The nozzle is then pulled back to the starting manhole. As the nozzle is pulled back, water scours the inside of the sanitary sewer pipe. Any debris in the pipe is pulled back with the water.

During cleaning of sanitary sewer lines, air occasionally vents into a home through the sanitary sewer service line and ventilation system.

**This procedure may remove the water in the traps in your home, please run the water for a few seconds in all sinks, tubs, showers and flush the toilet in order to fill your traps.**
