BRISTOL CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING
May 8, 2013

Minutes from April 3 2013 were approved with corrections.

OLD BUSINESS:

Dues to the NH Cemetery Association for 2013 have been paid.

Archie has talked to the Town Administrator concerning the prisoners from the County jail in Haverhill. Their time to do spring clean up in the Town's cemeteries, will be limited.

NEW BUSINESS:

Archie sent requests to four companies asking for quotes to do the cleaning/repair work at the Sanborn Cemetery. Only two companies replied: Perry Brothers, in Concord NH with a quote of \$4305.00 and Graveside Services of New England (GS of NE) in Bedford NH with a quote of \$3,360.00. It was voted unanimously that Graveside Services will do the cleaning /repair work but not before references are asked for, and to make sure the correct washing methods and materials are used to clean the stones. Archie will contact GS of NE for references and Ron will check with his contacts to get further references. If all references come back in the affirmative and cleaning methods are verified, Archie will contact the Cemetery Trustees and GSof NE will be hired.

Tom reported that the new wooden gate at the Sleeper Cemetery, next to Slim Baker Recreation Area, is in good shape.

Ron passed around information from the 2013 annual spring meeting of the NH Cemetery Association.
