To Our Water Customers:

This is a Consumer Confidence Report, that New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) requires us to send in July of every year. On the back side of this letter we have enclosed some water conservation ideas for the home. Also enclosed is a report of Bristol's water quality.

NHDES has prepared a Source Assessment Report for the sources serving this public water system. The results of the assessments are as follows. For Fowler River well, **2** susceptibility factors were rated high, **0** rated medium, and **10** were rated low. For Danforth Brook (Storm Center) **1** susceptibility factor was rated high, **1** rated medium and **10** rated low. The complete Assessment Report is available for inspection at the Water & Sewer Department Office. Just to recap on previous reports, our system serves over 1350 service connections. In the year 2009 the department pumped through its distribution system 111,906,000 gallons of water this was consumed by customers, fire protection and water main breaks. There is a million gallon storage tank on North Main Street; this enables us to provide fire protection through 158 fire hydrants as well as serve the distribution system.

We hope this report is beneficial to you, in understanding our Water System.

Water System improvements are underway with the refurbishing of Danforth Brook Well along with installation of a booster station at the intersection of Hillside Ave. and North Main Street. This is a 1.2 million dollar project to be completed by the end of this year. 50% of the project is being paid by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.
