

BRISTOL COMMUNITY EVENTS COMMITTEE 3/5/2010

PRESENT: Gylene Salmon, Christina McClay, Becky Burke, Les Dion, Barbara Greenwood, Debbie Gilbert

- Les Dion confirmed that Greg Gorski will be making his donation for the concert series through the TTCC.
- Becky Burke will prepare a poster to display at the polls on voting day and town meeting promoting the BCEC. Debbie Gilbert will get what photos she has for the pumpkin contest and the parades to her to add to what Christina McClay already has. Les Dion will create a sign up sheet for volunteers to put out with the poster.
- Discussion of Vendor permits was tabled until the next meeting. Some things to consider: single event permits, seasonal permits, blanket permits, non-profit and for-profit.
- Claire Moorehead's contract needs to be finalized and signed. It needs to include a clause making it contingent on the final outcome of Town Meeting.
- Discussion of the tie dye t-shirts. It was thought that if the Tie Dye Guy is not interested (needs to be confirmed through Claire Moorehead) the committee could pursue something similar on their own with t-shirts that are printed with the OHD logo on the left chest and a list of the concert series on the back recognizing Shop 'n Save as the sponsor. Debbie Gilbert reported that she had bought shirts for the library recently for \$6. Les Dion will check with the vendor that she uses for the TTCC to see if she can get a better price. T-shirt sale money will run through the TTCC. It was also suggested that we could ask the Tie Dye Guy to use our shirts.
- Les Dion will set up an account: Bristol Community Events and Parks and Recreation Fund.
- The concert list needs to be set by May 1st.
- Les Dion will check on the availability of the Way of the Woods for Old Home Day. Alternative suggestions are Reptiles on the Move and the Squam Lake Science Center.
- We need to check with Michele Bonsteel about inspecting the concession stand sometime in April. Barbara Greenwood OK'd the loan of the refrigerator that she donated to the library to be used in the concession stand for this season. Becky Burke will post a "wish-list" to the town website seeking the donation of a stove and shelving/cabinets.
- The next meeting will be Friday, April 2, 10:30 a.m. at the TTCC
