Meeting Minutes

Present: Joe Denning, Claire Moorhead, Marjie Gorman, Leslie Dion

Concerts: Claire reports that we have confirmations from all performers even though we only have three contracts at this point. We have not heard back from the 39th Army Band and if they should be able to come they will need two hours. Joe suggested we just pick an alternate week night for them. If we could get them for Old Home Day it would be perfect. Claire will follow up with them. Les had a meeting with Michael Capone and they decided that we need to go forward on getting the music licenses. She will take care of this. Marjie suggested that we sell Lobster & Chicken Dinner tickets all summer at the concerts. This is a great idea. We will not be doing t-shirt sales this year.

Advertising: Claire has the advertising in place. She reminded us that we had discussed doing 'rack cards' that could be placed in businesses and at realtors for distribution to their summer renters. It was also suggested we get info to all camps on the lake about the concerts. The rack cards would cost around \$350. We could also put all Old Home Day info and the Penny Sale on the back. Les will check with Rotary to see if they are willing to pay \$75 to have the Penny Sale info on these.

Budget: We reviewed the budget to date. We need to decide what we would like to do for the kids activities. A number of inflatable/game items were looked at from Unique Entertainment Rental. Les will follow up for pricing. The rest of the budget looks good.

Crafters: Les needs to get the crafter apps out ASAP. She will be sure to send one to the Tie Dye company that did concerts last year as well. We will also have this income.

Concert Refreshments: The Bristol Lion's Club & Leo's will be providing hotdogs, hamburgers and drinks for each concert. This can be added to all advertising. It was suggested that the Cub Scout troop from last year might be willing to do two 'Make Your Own Sundae' events during the summer at the concerts as well. We need to try to get a chest freezer that is an energy saver for use down at the concession building. Les will have this posted on our facebook and website. Les will have Derek take the salad bar chest out of the stand and take to the dump boutique.

Other Old Home Day Activities:

- Les had received info from a Scott Jamieson that does magic shows. He will come for free if he can sell tickets to the event. The concern was what the price of the tickets would be. This would have to be held in the TTCC on that day if people have to pay to go. Les will follow up with him and see how much he charges for the tickets.
- Facepainting – Les will check with Nikki to see if her facepainter is available during OHD. If not we will put it out that we are looking for someone.
- Horseshoes – Les will follow up with Gary Barney on this.
- Remax Balloon – It was agreed we would like to have them again. Les will follow up.

Other: Claire will send Les her invoice for payment.
