

**Bristol Community Events Committee**  
**July 2, 2010**  
**Meeting Minutes**

Secretary's Report: The May 7<sup>th</sup> and June 4<sup>th</sup> Secretary's Reports were reviewed.  
***Barbara Greenwood moved to accept both reports. Joe Denning seconded and the motion passed.***

Vendor Permits: The vendor permits have been updated and will be sent out next week.

Concert Update:

- Advertising: Claire Moorhead has offered to do the advertising for an additional fee of \$800-\$1,000. This would again be a contract with the Town of Bristol. It was agreed that we would like to do this. All concert bills will be paid by the Town of Bristol for this year. If the Shop N Save donation is given to the TTCC the TTCC will reimburse the Town for all expenses incurred up to the donated amount.
- Contracts: Les gave Christina all contracts except for the Crunchy Western Boys as she has not received it yet.
- T-shirt order: Becky did a great job on the logo for the back of the shirts. Les has them being printed at Piche's and will pick them up on Wednesday. They will be ready to sell for Thursdays concert. The cost will be \$10 per shirt.
- We need to cover the Concession Stand for the upcoming weeks. Barb will check and see if Minot Sleeper Library is interested in doing the first one. Les said the TTCC would do the second one and Christina will check with Gylene to see if the Explorers will do the third one. Les will follow up with Bristol Nursery School to see if they are interested in doing this again this year.
- We need to meet and clean up the concession building. It was agreed to meet on Wednesday morning at 9:30 am.

4<sup>th</sup> of July:

- Parade: Joe reports that they are all set for the parade. They have the kazoo band, two bands on flatbeds and many floats.
- Fireworks: The fireworks will be set off on a barge at dusk on July 3<sup>rd</sup> at the foot of the lake. The Bristol Lion's Club will be selling food that night.

Old Home Day:

- Bingo: Have not had a response from the Chamber on this as yet.

- Inflatable Obstacle Course: Les talked to a company from Thornton that does this. They have worked with the School District before. It was agreed to order the Giant Inflatable Obstacle Course for \$750 to be there from 10:30 – 2:30.
- Road Race: Karen Schaffner has this under control and it will begin at 8:30 am.
- Softball Tournament: It was agreed that we want to move forward with this. The Police and Fire Departments have expressed interest in entering teams. We need to get posters out and see if we can get someone to organize it. It was agreed we would charge \$10/team and give out a trophy to the winning team.
- Horseshoes: Les has spoken with Gary Barney and we are all set. We just need to order the trophies.
- Face Painting: Christina will follow up on this.
- Pony Rides: Joe thinks we are all set but will double check.
- Craft Fair: Apps are going out next week.
- ReMax Balloon: Les has contacted them and is waiting to hear if it will be available again this year.
- Antique Car Parade: Joe said the Lion's are all set with this.
- Spaghetti Supper: Les contacted the BFD and will be attending their meeting next Tuesday. It sounds like they are interested in doing it again.
- Lobster Supper: All set.
- Rain Date: There was discussion on if we should pick a rain date or rain plan since we were rained out last year. The overall feeling was that we should see if we can secure NMMS for a back up plan. Christina will put in a request for the Old Home Day activities and Les will put in a request for the Lobster & Chicken Supper. It approved we will advertise it this way and would only have to cancel a few things.
- Food Vendors: Lion's are all set.
