

Bristol Energy Committee Meeting
July 12, 2010

The monthly meeting of the Bristol Energy Committee was held at the town office building at 3:30. We are very pleased that George Corrette and Nathan Haselbauer want to be on this committee. The selectmen will be notified of their interest.

Lucille reported on the State Energy Conference she attended on June 19 in Concord. Of particular interest is the Energy Technical Assistance Planning for NH Communities Program. This program assists towns with energy inventories as a first step toward reducing energy consumption and carbon release. Nathan is going to call for more information.

Discussion was held about how effective the no idling signs have been. There is concern that town vehicles are being left on for extended periods of time. Some towns have a no idling policy for town vehicles. Perhaps more signs should be put up at various locations one being the town beaches.

Nathan suggested that the town could be making mulch or compost at the transfer station rather than burning and releasing CO₂. He and Ron Giles will talk to Mark Bucklin about this.
