**MINUTES OF APRIL 12, 2016**

The following amendments and clarifications were made: Page 1, date of the meeting – delete “January” and replace with “April”. 1<sup>st</sup> paragraph, 5<sup>th</sup> line, following “and” insert “provide the background work for”. Page 2, under GOALS, #1., 6<sup>th</sup> line, following “there are” insert “N.H. Humanities Council”. #4., 2<sup>nd</sup> line, following “old house.” Insert “Mr. Dingman said yes.” Page 3, Selectmen's Report, 3<sup>rd</sup> line, delete “on the Old Town Hall,”.

D. Gordon made a motion, second by S. Heaney, to approve the minutes as amended. The motion carried.

**FINALIZE HISTORIC RESOURCES CHAPTER:**

The Commission went over the draft and made a couple of minor adjustments. They then looked at the proposed maps and determined that on Exhibit A, they would change the names to street addresses. On Exhibit B it was felt that the first 4 columns should be changed: reference number, address, Historic name, and also known to be the replacement. Exhibit C, they determined to eliminate the small colored circles, remove the inventory information, and remove the gray lines of all non-aged buildings and the “0-49 yrs.”. It was suggested that Structures be added to the title and to use a red outline for the HDC District.

The Commission approved the amended Chapter and Mr. Dingman will make the edits as stated this evening. He will then send them on to the Planning Board.

With no other business before the Commission, it was decided that they will only meet if there is an agenda/hearing.
