

**INVITATION TO BID**  
**Cummings Beach Improvements**

The Town of Bristol NH is inviting bids for constructing a stone retaining wall, granite stairs and grass pathway at Cummings Beach on West Shore Road.

The work, in general, includes excavation, removal of the installation of the stone wall, granite steps, loam and seed, turf establishment, and erosion control.

The Town of Bristol requests that the work be performed by the successful bidders' own personnel. Any subcontractors must be pre-approved by the Town.

All work must be completed by December 15, 2018.

Bid price proposals must be on company letterhead clearly stating the total lump sum price for the work. The lump sum price will include site preparation, excavation, excavation support, disposal of excess materials, wall materials and construction, backfill materials, stone bedding and stone backfill, filter fabric, granite steps, crushed gravel, loam, seeding, turf establishment, compliance with permit conditions, all incidentals as required to complete the work, and all work indicated on the drawings by KVPartners, LLC entitled Cummings Beach Improvements dated August 2018 (revision date 9-22-18). Plans are available in digital form from the Town or KVPartners. The lump sum bid is intended to be for the entire project complete in place and no request for increase in contract price shall be entertained by the Town.

All work to be done under the direction of the Town or their designee.

The Town of Bristol reserves the right to reject any and all bids, re-bid, negotiate any contracts, to waive irregularities in the proposals, and to accept the proposal which, in the Town's sole discretion, best serves the interest of the Town, and waive any formalities in the bid process.

The contractor will be required to provide an insurance certificate confirming the following insurance coverage; *worker's compensation insurance as required by the State of NH; broad-form comprehensive general liability insurance in the amount no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence; and motor vehicle insurance to include bodily injury, property damage, uninsured motorist, and employer's non-ownership coverage in the amount no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence.* The Town of Bristol shall be named as an additional insured on all policies.

The contractor must also agree in writing to indemnify the Town of Bristol from any and all liability, loss or damage, including but not limited to bodily injury, illness, death or property damage, which the Town becomes legally obligated to pay as a result of claims, demands, costs, or judgment against the Town arising out of the contractor's actions or omissions relating to this project.
